

Bottpower XR-1 frame kit

BOTTPOWER, a Spanish manufacturer best known for its Moto2 GP race bikes, is developing a frame kit for use with Buell XB components.

The BOTT XR-1 uses the engine, swingarm, suspension, wheels and brakes from Buell bikes to create a modern flat track styled bike based on the looks of H-D's XR750.

Designed to be sold as a kit of parts, which includes a new steel chassis, main fuel tank and secondary fuel tank, subframe, seat/tail, front plate, lights, a

side intake kit for the engine's fuel injection, footrests, and handlebar, the XR-1 was developed after Bottpower was approached by Ramón Bellosta who wanted a Buell derived bike building.

Bottpower plans to have the first kits available in August or September 2011.
